



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Name of the Event: Company Specific Aptitude Training for IV year students





The Partner shall not disclose, reproduce or use any Confidential Information for any purpose except solely in connection with the performance of this MOU. Upon expiration or termination of this MOU, Partner shall cease using all such Confidential Information, in whatever form. The Partner or any of its personnel/ students/ faculty shall not disclose the Confidential Information during the term of this MOU and for a period of 5 years after.

The Parties shall not make unauthorized use of the trade name, trade mark, copyright, patent, symbol, licenses, or designation belonging to the other party without prior approval and permission. In the event, the Partner or any of its personnel/students/faculty breach its confidentiality obligations or infringe the intellectual property of RITS.RITS shall have the right to pursue appropriate remedies available at law and shall be entitled to equitable relief. 
