



## 3.4.1 Extension activities carried out during the academic year 2022-23

The National Service Scheme (NSS) conducts a week-long residential camp in the nearby adopted village, where NSS volunteers engage in diverse activities addressing social concerns such as cleanliness, tree plantation, AIDS awareness, blood donation camps, and health check-up initiatives.
